Steve continued, "Waterline Systems is the perfect builder for Colgate 26s as they currently build the Alerion yacht line, and will provide that same high quality in producing the Colgate 26, known as *The Boat For All Reasons* because it is so versatile and safe in all wind and sea conditions." The Colgate 26 replaced Solings in Offshore Sailing School's fleet in 1997, when it was named *Cruising World* magazine's "Boat of the Year." The Colgate 26 was originally manufactured by Precision BoatWorks in Palmetto, Fla. Waterline Systems will now service Colgate 26 sailboats at either of its facilities.
